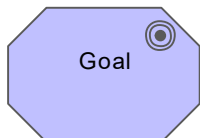
A **Stakeholder** represents an interested party who is influential in architectural decisions.



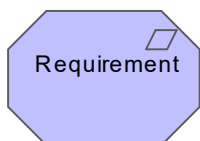
A **Driver** represents a motivation for change in an organisation.



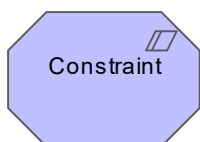
An **Assessment** documents strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats.



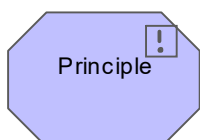
A **Goal** defines an objective to address an assessment.



A **Requirement** specifies a change needed to implement a goal.



A **Constraint** indicates a restriction on how goals can be addressed.



A **Principle** defines a standard or policy to guide how goals are implemented.



A stakeholder can be an **aggregate** that contains 1 or more other stakeholders.



A stakeholder is **associated** with 1 or more drivers.



An external driver **influences** an internal driver.



A driver is **associated** with 1 or more assessments.



An assessment is **associated** with 1 or more goals.



An requirement **realizes** (implements) a goal.



A constraint **realizes** (restricts the implementation of) a goal.



A principle **realizes** (guides the implementation of) a goal.
